

## PASS Program Behavior Policy

Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s) and Students,

In the PASS Program, we want to provide a safe environment that promotes appropriate social interactions. In order to do that we have developed the following behavior rules:

1. *Self Respect:* We expect students to follow directions and rules.
2. *Mutual Respect:* We expect students to express their feelings and thoughts to others with appropriate words.
3. *Respect for Materials and Property:* Materials and equipment are to be used with care.

**\*Please Note:** Immediate removal from the program will occur if a student exhibits physical behavior that risks the safety of his/her self or another PASS Program student(s) or Staff.

The PASS Program uses a 3 Card system daily to encourage positive student behavior at our program; students who exhibit positive behavior are recognized.

The following actions may be taken if a child fails to comply with the PASS program rules:

1. A verbal warning to the student and his/ her parent(s)/guardian will be notified.
2. Suspension from the program for a designated number of days (at the discretion of administration).
3. Removal from the program with parent(s)/guardian notification.
