

CONSTRUCTION CAREER DAYS EXPECTATIONS OF STUDENTS

Massachusetts Construction Career Day (Mass CCD) is an exciting opportunity for you to learn about and experience first-hand the wide range of careers available in the construction industry. You will be exposed to a wide variety of experiences and information. **By registering with your school, you have made a commitment to attend Construction Career Day.** To ensure that everyone gets the most out of the day, we have listed some rules and guidelines to follow:

- **Dress Code:** For safety reasons it is important that you dress according to these guidelines for Construction Career Day:
 1. Wear long pants, sturdy shoes (**no sandals or open-toe shoes**) and a comfortable jersey.
 2. Bring a warm coat or raingear in the event of cold or rainy weather. Some of the most interesting exhibits will be outside.
 3. **Do not** wear: scarves, loose or long jewelry, hanging belts or key chains or any excessively loose clothing or items that could get caught in machinery.
- Listen to and stay with your chaperones all day.
- Follow all the safety and security polices and procedures of the event.
- Use of tobacco products will **not** be permitted at the construction career day site. Do not chew gum. **No electronic devices are allowed on site including iPods and cell phones.**
- Greet the presenters with a smile and a firm handshake!
- Make eye contact with people who are speaking to you. If you do not understand them, ask them in a polite way to repeat themselves.
- Use this opportunity to learn; ask questions of the presenters, find out how they got to where they are, about their company, about the pros and cons of their field of work, etc.
- Make sure you thank presenters for the opportunity to spend time with them. They have volunteered to do this in order to help *you*!
