Section 1 - Introduction

The Massachusetts Perkins IV Secondary Postsecondary Career/Vocational Technical Education Linkage Initiative implements tech-prep performance indicators as required by the Title II “Tech-Prep Education” in the Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Education Improvement Act of 2006 Public Law 109-270 (Perkins IV).

Perkins IV Secondary Postsecondary Career/Vocational Technical Education Linkage Consortia staff and members should review the official copy of Perkins IV and not rely on excerpts contained in this Accountability Workbook. Staff and members should also review the Massachusetts Perkins IV Manual at http://www.doe.mass.edu/cte/perkins/funding_manual.doc as well as the Massachusetts Perkins IV Secondary Postsecondary Career/Vocational Technical Education Linkage Manual at <http://www.doe.mass.edu/cte/techprep/consortiummanual.pdf>.

Perkins IV sets forth tech-prep performance indicators for the first time. Perkins IV provides for the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education and each individual Perkins IV Secondary Postsecondary Career/Vocational Technical Education Linkage Consortium to reach agreement on performance levels for each tech-prep performance indicator.

This Massachusetts Perkins IV Secondary Postsecondary Career/Vocational Technical Education Linkage Accountability Workbook is for 2010-2013. It will facilitate each Perkins IV Secondary Postsecondary Career/Vocational Technical Education Linkage Consortium in reaching agreement with the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education on performance levels for each tech-prep performance indicator for Performance Years 4 (2010-2011); 5 (2011-2012) and 6 (2012-2013). This Accountability Workbook also provides guidance on the development of Tech-Prep Improvement Plans based on Performance Year 3 results.

The Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education may terminate funding for individual Perkins IV Secondary Postsecondary Career/Vocational Technical Education Linkage Consortia and the entire Perkins IV Secondary Postsecondary Career/Vocational Technical Education Initiative for any fiscal year based in part or completely on tech-prep performance indicator results.

Section 2 - Definitions

The definitions below are directly related to this Accountability Workbook. Additional definitions are contained in the Massachusetts Perkins IV Secondary Postsecondary Career/Vocational Technical Education Linkage Manual at <http://www.doe.mass.edu/cte/techprep/consortiummanual.pdf>. Additional definitions pertaining to Perkins IV are provided in the Act itself, and in the Massachusetts Perkins IV Manual both of which are available through links posted at <http://www.doe.mass.edu/cte/perkins/>.

Agreed-Upon Performance Level

This term is used to denote the performance level on a tech-prep performance indicator that a Perkins IV Secondary Postsecondary Career/Vocational Technical Education Linkage Consortium agreed to reach.

ESE is the acronym for the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education.

Industry-Recognized Credential is a credential issued to an individual by a public agency, educational institution, private organization, or other that indicates a level of occupational competency. The Massachusetts Certificate of Occupational Proficiency will be such a credential.

Performance Years

Performance Year 1 is 2007-2008

Performance Year 2 is 2008-2009

Performance Year 3 is 2009-2010

Performance Year 4 is 2010-2011

Performance Year 5 is 2011-2012

Performance Year 6 is 2012-2013

Postsecondary Tech-Prep Participant is a student who was a secondary tech-prep participant while enrolled in high school and is now enrolled in a postsecondary career and technical education program in a public two-year college.

Secondary Tech-Prep Participant is a student enrolled in a career and technical education program on the secondary level in a school district that has a Perkins IV Local Plan. The school districts with Perkins IV Local Plans are included as members of Secondary Postsecondary Career/Vocational Technical Education Linkage Consortia. Tech-Prep Actual Performance Level is used to denote the actual performance level attained by consortium on a tech-prep performance indicator.

Tech-Prep Improvement Plan

Refer to Section 5 of this Accountability Workbook titled “Tech-Prep Improvement Plans.”

Tech-Prep Performance Indicators are given in Appendix B. **Important Note:** Tech-Prep Performance Indicator **1STP3** (Secondary Tech-Prep Participants Who Received an Industry-Recognized Credential) will not be implemented until the Massachusetts Certificate of Occupational Proficiency system is developed and implemented.

Tech-Prep Performance Indicator Data Report

Refer to Section 3 of this Accountability Workbook titled “Understanding Tech-Prep Actual Performance Levels” for information pertaining to the Tech-Prep Performance Indicator Data Report.

Tech-Prep Performance Indicator Measurement Definitions

Measurement definitions for tech-prep performance indicators are given in Appendix B.

Section 3 - Understanding Tech-Prep Actual Performance Levels

The Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education calculates the actual performance levels for tech-prep performance indicators using the measurement definitions given in the Tech-Prep Performance Indicator Measurement Definitions Chart in Appendix B and the data in the Massachusetts Perkins IV Public Two-Year College/Postsecondary Consortium Career and Technical Education Data Report.

The actual performance levels are reported to each Perkins IV Secondary Postsecondary Career/Vocational Technical Education Linkage Consortium in January in a Tech-Prep Performance Indicator Data Report (one for each tech-prep performance indicator.)

Section 4 - Reaching Agreement During 2010-2013 on Tech-Prep Performance Levels for Performance Year 4 (2010-2011); 5 (2011-2012) and 6 (2012-2013)

Perkins IV requires that the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education and each consortium reach agreement on minimum performance levels for the tech-prep performance indicators. **Important Note:** Tech-Prep Performance Indicator **1STP3** (Secondary Tech-Prep Participants Who Received an Industry-Recognized Credential) will not be implemented until the Massachusetts Certificate of Occupational Proficiency system is developed and implemented.

Steps in the Process for Reaching Agreement During 2010-2013 on Tech-Prep Performance Levels for Performance Year 4 (2010-2011); 5 (2011-2012) and 6 (2012-2013)

Step 1 - The consortium members and staff shall review each Tech-Prep Performance Indicator Data Report provided in July 2010 by the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education.

Step 2 - Using the Tech-Prep Performance Level Agreement Chart (found in Appendix C of this workbook), the consortium shall propose performance levels for each tech-prep performance indicator for Performance Years 4 (2010-2011), 5 (2011-2012) and 6 (2012-2013) with the exception of 1STP3.

Step 3 - The consortium coordinator shall email the completed Tech-Prep Performance Level Agreement Chart, to Karen DeCoster in the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education kdecoster@doe.mass.edu by September 30, 2010.

Step 4 - The Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education will review the proposed performance levels taking into account the factors as described below. The Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education may require that modifications be made to the proposed performance levels based on the review.

When considering proposed performance levels during the agreement process, the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education will take into account the following:

- How the proposed performance levels compare with the performance levels proposed by other consortia, taking into account factors that may be identified by the consortium including the characteristics of students when the students became secondary tech-prep participants and postsecondary tech-prep participants, as well as the services to be provided. In addition, the extent to which the proposed performance level will promote continuous improvement on the performance indicator by the consortium will be considered.

Step 5 - The consortium and the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education will agree upon Performance Levels for Performance Years 4 (2010-2011), 5 (2011-2012) and 6 (2012-2013) by October 29, 2010.

Step 6 - The Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education will email the Local Adjusted Performance Level Negotiation Chart to the consortium coordinator after the negotiations have concluded so that the consortium will have a record of the final agreed-upon Tech-Prep Performance Levels for Performance Years 4 (2010-2011), 5 (2011-2012) and 6 (2012-2013).

Revisions to Agreed-Upon Performance Levels

The consortium may request revisions to the agreed-upon performance level for any tech-prep performance indicator if extenuating circumstances exist. The request must be submitted by the consortium coordinator in writing addressed to Karen DeCoster, Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, 75 Pleasant Street, Malden, MA 02148. The request must include documentation that extenuating circumstances exist. The Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education will respond in writing to the request within ten (10) business days of receipt.

Section 5 - Tech-Prep Improvement Plans

Tech-Prep Improvement Plans (if required) will be submitted by April 30, 2011.

Step 1 - The consortium shall review its Tech-Prep Performance Indicator Data Reports for Performance Year 4 issued in July 2010. If a consortium has a tech-prep performance indicator that failed to meet at least 90 percent (90%) of the agreed upon performance level for the tech-prep performance indicator, the consortium will be required to develop and implement a Tech-Prep Improvement Plan for the performance indicator. **Note that in cases where the denominator for the performance indicator contains less than 16 students, the consortium is not required to develop and implement a Tech-Prep Improvement Plan for that performance indicator.**

Step 2 - The consortium shall access the Tech-Prep Improvement Plan Template in Appendix D of this Accountability Workbook.

Step 3 - The consortium shall use one Tech-Prep Improvement Plan Template for each performance indicator that failed to meet at least 90 percent (90%) of the agreed-upon performance level for the performance indicator, (except that for cases where the denominator

contains less than 16 students the consortium is not required to develop and implement a Tech-Prep Improvement Plan for that performance indicator.)

Step 4 - The consortium shall list on the Tech-Prep Improvement Plan Template the individuals that were consulted in the development of the Tech-Prep Improvement Plan.

Step 5 - The consortium shall describe in the Tech-Prep Improvement Plan Template the Tech-Prep Improvement Plan that was developed.

Step 6 - The consortium shall email the completed Tech-Prep Improvement Plan Template to Karen DeCoster in the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education at kdecoster@doe.mass.edu by **April 30, 2011**.

Step 7 - The Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education will review the Tech-Prep Improvement Plan(s) submitted by the consortium.

Step 8 - The Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education will notify the consortium coordinator if the Tech-Prep Improvement Plan(s) does not meet minimum requirements so that the consortium will revise and resubmit them as necessary.

Step 9 - The Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education will notify the consortium coordinator by email when the Tech-Prep Improvement Plan has been deemed to meet minimum requirements.

Step 10 - The consortium will implement the Tech-Prep Improvement Plan.

Revisions to the Local Perkins Improvement Plan

The consortium may revise its Tech-Prep Improvement Plans. Revised Tech-Prep Improvement Plans shall be submitted by email to Karen DeCoster in the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education at kdecoster@doe.mass.edu prior to implementation. The Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education will follow the steps outlined above resulting in revisions deemed to meet minimum requirements.

This chart lists the performance indicators, defines what each performance indicator measures, and gives the measurement definitions that the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education uses to develop Tech-Prep Performance Indicator Data Reports for each consortium. Note that the dates given in the measurement definitions are the dates used to compute Performance Year 3 results.
