(A) Has 12% of children or more **OR** 1000 children or more from families with incomes below the poverty line (based on U.S. Census); **AND**

(B) (i) operates one or more schools identified under section 1116; **OR** (ii) has a substantial need for assistance in acquiring and using technology (based on Local Technology Benchmark Standards for 2003).
