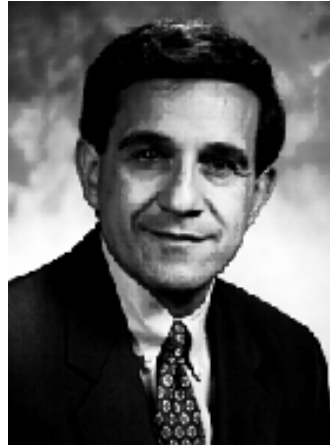

## Commissioner's Update

### Chapter 74 Nonresident Tuition Rates for FY 1996

**To:** Superintendents, Superintendent-Directors

**From:** Robert V. Antonucci, Commissioner of Education

Attached are the approved Chapter 74 nonresident tuition rates for school year 1995-96. These rates apply to regular secondary and postgraduate Chapter 74 nonresidents. Rates for students in bilingual or special education Chapter 74 programs should be negotiated between the vocational-technical school and the city or town of residence. The additional cost added to the regular tuition rate must be based on per hour costs projected for the supplemental services required by the student.

An updated copy of the nonresident application is also enclosed for your use. School districts are reminded that the only reasons for disapproving nonresident placements should be: 1) failure to adhere to application deadlines or 2) the local availability of the desired vocational course offering. Every effort should be made by districts to locally resolve disagreements regarding nonresident placements prior to submission for a Department ruling.

In March 1994, we sent superintendents a seven page memorandum outlining the Chapter 74 nonresident process.
