
Monitoring Students' Risk throughout the Year

Research shows that ABC's – attendance, behavior & course performance – are particularly powerful indicators of students' academic risk. Examining these at regular intervals and comparing them to thresholds or cut points allow educators to identify students if they begin to go off track and take action right away.

DESE's Monitoring Tool is oriented around the <u>Early Warning Implementation Cycle</u>. Navigate through the Tool using steps of the cycle from the Main Menu or from the navigation bar. Click on More Info for pop-up instructions.
