

PLANNING FOR ENGLISH LEARNER SUCCESS

Planning for English Learner Success is a flexible change planning process to improve English learners' experiences and outcomes based on the Massachusetts <u>Vision for English Learner Education</u> and <u>Blueprint for English Learners Success</u>.

Educator teams can use it to address priority improvement areas identified in *Module 2: Self-Assessment with the Blueprint*

1 Explore the Problem Explore an improvement area, identify the underlying problem, and reach consensus on root causes and contributing factors using a **fishbone diagram** and relevant data

2 Develop Goals and Change Ideas

Collaboratively develop goals for improvement and select change ideas to implement to reach goals using a **driver diagram** and relevant data

Identify actions to implement change ideas selected and map out tasks, persons responsible, a timeline, progress monitoring measures, and other key considerations
