Is PRISM III Cohort 2 Right for You?



The Partnership for Reading Success – Massachusetts (PRISM) III grant is designed to support literacy achievement for students in **grades 4–12**. The grant provides funding and guidance to districts, collaboratives, and charter schools to evaluate, select, purchase, launch, and implement high-quality instructional materials (HQIM) for ELA/literacy in **grades 4-12**, so that students experience relevant, real-world literacy learning aligned with high expectations.

When deciding whether to apply to PRISM III, consider:

Does at least one school in my district, charter, or collaborative, have at least 50% identified low-income students (40% for high schools)?
