

# Partnership for Reading Success – Massachusetts (PRISM II) Preschool Curriculum Review Process Cohort 2 Track 2



PRISM II Cohort 2 grantees that include preschool will engage in preschool-specific process of curriculum selection and implementation. This process supports grantees to review preschool curriculum materials and quality reports (including EEC's criteria for high-quality preschool curriculum), select a preschool curriculum appropriate for their context, and strategically strengthen their preschool curriculum supports for language and literacy.

## What is involved in the Preschool Curriculum Review Process?

- Establishing a Preschool Curriculum Review Team
- Monthly virtual 1 hour EEC-facilitated Preschool Review Team Meetings
- Individual and team activities between sessions (e.g., reading reports, gathering data, reviewing curriculum materials, team discussions)
- Optional office hours with the facilitators
