Department FMR Findings:

A review of documents and administrative interviews indicated that although the charter school has a plan to review its academic programming, the school does not evaluate all aspects of its fourth through eighth grade program annually to ensure that all students, regardless of race, color, sex, gender identity, religion, national origin, limited English proficiency, sexual orientation, disability, or housing status, have equal access to all programs, including athletics and other extracurricular activities.

Description of Corrective Action:

MCCPS will review its academic program and implement changes to ensure student access. Each trimester, this review will occur during our student success team meetings. While most students are MCCPS are fully included in the academic program, we discuss ways to support individual students' needs during these meetings. If the student does not have access to part of the educational program, we will use this meeting time to design opportunities to ensure student participation. These changes could include modified schedules, co-planning units of study for inclusion opportunities, and curriculum UDL (Universal Design for Learning) review.

Additionally, MCCPS will develop and revise a checklist for extracurricular and cocurricular programs (including but not limited too, athletics, theatre, and field trip programs) to ensure access to these programs for all learners. These checklists will consist of steps for:

providing programmatic communication in multiple languages scholarship opportunities

providing staff support with special education needs

transportation support

reaching out to service providers to promote program participation

MCCPS will provide teachers and service providers training during our regular meetings (special education consult, student success team, and grade-level team meetings) on planning for inclusion. Each trimester, MCCPS will train new extracurricular program providers and review checklist completion for returning providers.

At the end of each year, the MCCPS Leadership Team (Head of School, Principal, and Director of Student Services) will review data from the academic and extracurricular programs. The review will include demographic data from each program, meeting agendas, training participation, and checklist reviews. After reviewing this data, the Leadership Team will determine what changes need to be made to ensure student access to these programs.
