Networking Planning Event Series	Each team will have access to remote networking events that will support district and school level MTSS planning. Topics will include systemic factors such as staffing, scheduling, and budgeting.	Audience: All members of the school or district planning team for district or school improvement plans. E.g. district leadership team, ILT, school council, etc.
Monthly Planning Newsletters	From August-June, a planning newsletter will be provided to participating teams. These newsletters include planning and implementation products, resources, and protocols. This first one serves as an overview of the Academy.	Audience: Administrators
Monthly Leadership Webinars	Administrators can join monthly leadership webinars. These webinars will offer opportunities to learn about vital academy content, collaborate with other leaders, provide access to planning resources as well as the opportunity to ask questions of an MTSS planning expert. We will be tracking attendance and giving PDP certs.	Audience: Administrators
Online Personalized Planning Support Sessions	All new cohort teams and returning teams identified by data outcomes will be provided with personalized planning and leadership support sessions. These sessions will support the design of improvement plans in the area of literacy. Each new team will receive at least 2 sessions and returning members will receive tiered support based on outcomes (up to monthly).	Audience: All members of the school or district planning team for district or school improvement plans, e.g. ILT, school council members, etc. Personalized dates determined between the team and TA provider.



<p>8 Site-Specific Technical Assistance Sessions for <u>All Districts</u></p>	<p>The topics and format of TA are specific to each team and the needs identified in their data and improvement plans. The 8 TA sessions may include PD during established meeting times, modeling of instruction, co-planning lessons during existing planning blocks, co-teaching lessons during class, or observing practice and providing mastery-oriented feedback. Districts with more than 4 participating teams will be granted more than 8 days. Services will be provided remotely to start the FY21 school year. Instructional support (PD and planning) will focus on the modality of the school’s reopening plan (e.g. socially distanced, hybrid, remote).</p>	<p>Audience: The entire staff of the participating school.</p> <p>Personalized dates determined between the district and TA provider.</p>
<p>8 Remote Coach Support Sessions Per Level</p>	<p>To support scaling, we will offer remote support sessions for school-based or district level literacy coaches. We will offer 16 half day online regional support sessions for school-based or district level literacy coaches. 8 will be focused on elementary 8 on secondary.</p>	<p>Audience: This is a train-the-trainer open to the team’s designated instructional coach(es).</p> <p>September-April</p>
<p>Webinars</p>	<p>We will offer two one-hour live webinars. The content and presentation will be focused on instructional strategies to support comprehensive literacy. Time: 3:45-4:45</p>	<p>Audience: Any member of the participating school’s staff who register.</p>
<p>Book Group Facilitation Manuals</p>	<p>We are providing teams with a set of book group facilitation protocols to support the use of onsite book clubs related to supporting relevant student cohorts. The academy does not provide the books nor track participation.</p>	<p>All facilitation manuals will be housed in CANVAS.</p>
<p>1 Train the Trainer Graduate Course Seat</p>	<p>1 person per team will take this course in order to teach it back onsite. The course is fully online and the 5 synchronous sessions are after school hours. The course is free and participants will get PDPs.
